Filling out the Bid Application Form

This guide follows the blanks on the Bid Application Form from top to bottom.

OGRID No. Enter your OGRID number here. If you do not have one, contact Paulette Lucero-Romero at (505) 827-5714 or <u>plucero@slo.state.nm.us</u>.

Name of legal entity or personal name —This is the name in which the lease will be issued; it will be the <u>lessee of record</u>. This can be the name of a company or of an individual.

Mailing address – This is the address of the potential leaseholder.

The <u>following five blanks</u> require information to be recorded exactly as you find in the SLO monthly Oil and Gas Lease Sale Notice. The information includes the <u>tract number</u> in the sale, the name of the <u>county</u> in which it lies, <u>the legal land description</u> describing the tract on which you are bidding, whether it is a <u>regular</u> sale <u>or special</u> sale, and how many <u>acres</u> the tract contains. Note that some of the portions are already filled in, to give you a guide to proper annotation.

EXAMPLE: 001 S12 T13S R28E

Sealed: V0-001 Description W2NW4, SE4NW4, SW4

Notice the V0 –type lines are different for sealed and oral bids.

The amount of dollars that you enter in the next blank is your bid. Notice that your first year's rental is included in your bid. Your bid on a 320-acre tract may be \$10,000; if the rental rate on that tract is \$1/acre, we will apply \$320 of your \$10,000 to the first year's rental.

The amount of dollars that you enter in the "Total remittance" blank is your bid <u>plus</u> the \$30.00 application fee. In the above example, you would remit \$10,030.

Name of applicant or agent – This blank is for the <u>printed name</u> of either the applicant or the agent of the applicant.

<u>Signature</u> – The form must be signed in the presence of a <u>notary public</u>. The signature here is of the person named in the previous, "printed name" blank.

Acknowledgment section – Your notary public will complete the remainder of the form.

Remember that the bid application and your remittance must be in the Accounting office of the State Land Office before 9:30 a.m. the day of the oil and gas lease sale.



Dear Representative of the Oil and Gas Industry:

On March 25, 2014, I signed a Candidate Conservation Agreement with Assurances (CCAA) with the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and the Center of Excellence for Hazardous Material Management (CEHMM). With the USFWS's recent decision to list the Lesser Prairie Chicken (LPC) as a "threatened" species under the Endangered Species Act, I would like to make sure you are aware of your ability to utilize the protections afforded under the CCAA.

This agreement, which enrolls approximately 404,000 acres of State Trust Land under the voluntary conservation program, is aimed at ensuring that regardless of USFWS listing decisions under the Endangered Species Act participating State Land Office lessees will be able to continue their operations. The accord covers both Lesser Prairie Chicken and the Dunes Sagebrush Lizard (DSL) habitat. In 2012 I signed a similar agreement, which at the time represented one of the largest accords in the nation with more than 247,000 acres. This new agreement replaces and expands this effort.

Participation in the CCAA helps ensure that oil and gas activities can continue in areas inhabited by the LPC and/or the DSL while meeting conservation objectives for these two species. By enrolling these State Trust Lands under the program, lessees of these lands will also be able to enroll if they chose to do so, even though the listing decision for the LPC has already been published.

This agreement will help protect the health of our lands while allowing economic activity that supports State Land Trust beneficiaries, which include public schools, hospitals, and universities, to continue. In the absence of a CCAA, state land use and development in the species' range may be delayed by the requisite USFWS consultation process. By agreeing to conduct certain conservation measures the USFWS provides regulatory certainty (assurances) concerning land use restrictions that might otherwise apply due to LPC or DSL listing decisions.

Some measures required under the CCAA to protect the LPC and DSL include:

- Providing escape ramps for open water sources;
- Minimizing surface disturbances;

- Avoiding DSL habitat;
- Burying power lines within two miles of LPC lek sites active at least once in the past five years;
- Burying power lines within one mile of historic LPC lek site.

Enrollment eligibility and associated deadlines may differ based on each applicant's circumstances. Please contact CEHMM as soon as possible if you have questions.

I am also writing to encourage all oil and gas lessees to participate in this voluntary program. The health of our State Trust Lands and the success of the oil and gas industry are of great importance to New Mexicans. This agreement helps ensure the future of both.
