It is further agreed that failure to comply with these requirements shall *ipso facto* render this Assignment null and void.
- It is agreed that the Assignee is the same as the Oil Conservation Division Operator ("Operator") or a subsidiary of the Operator. If the Grantee is a subsidiary of the Operator, please attach relevant data to support this.
